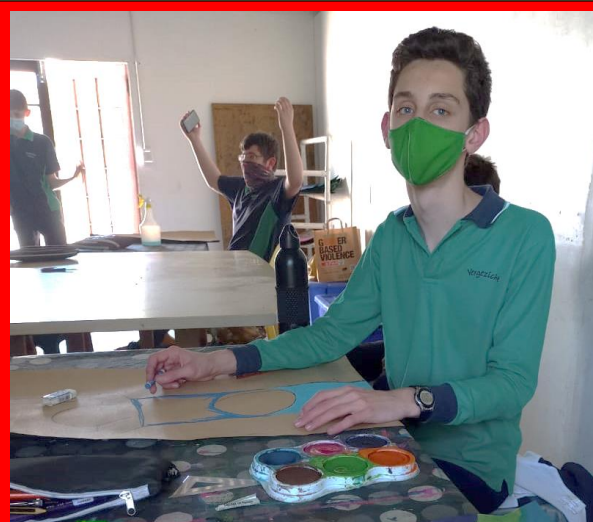

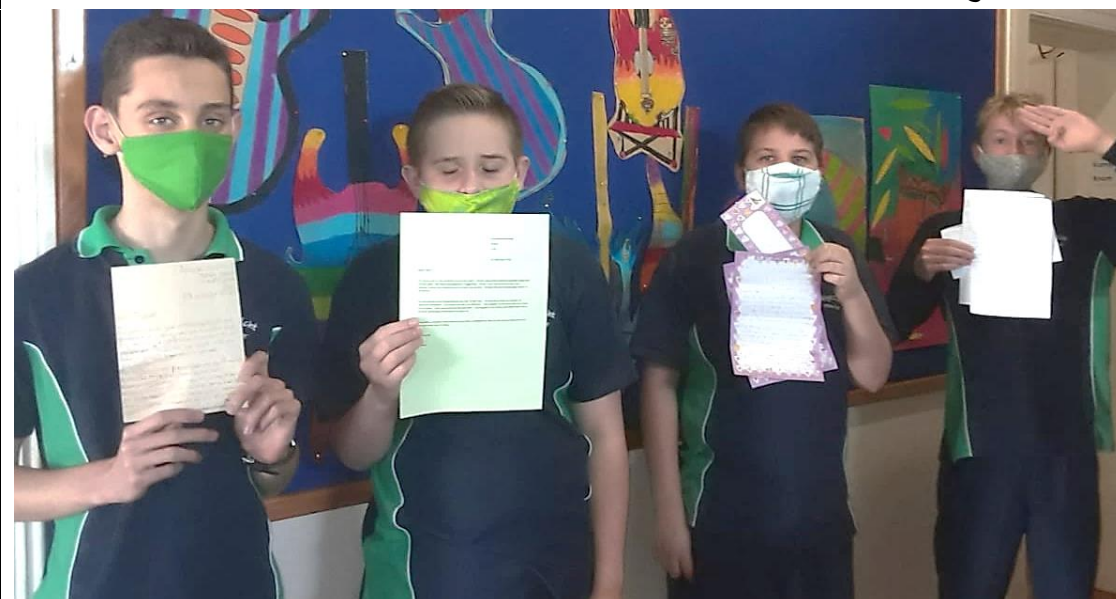
He received awards for Academic Excellence, as well as the Science Award. Zander achieved an average of 80% during 2020.
